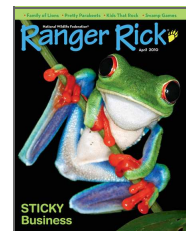
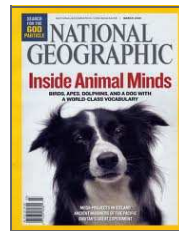
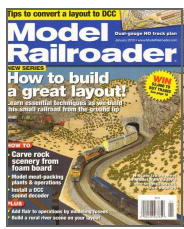
BOOK CERTIFICATES

These are just a few of the many magazines you can find at your local library. Each month we will be featuring a few to give you a glimpse of what is available.

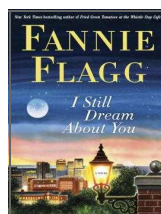
AMERICAN SPIRIT - Patriotism, American history, historic preservation, genealogy, & education issues important to us all.

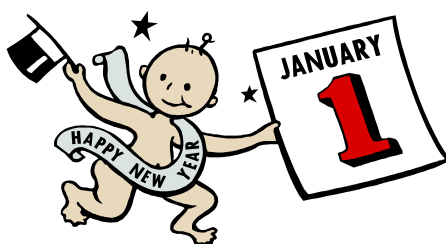
DRAGON DAY - Saturday, January 14 @ 10:00 AM for kids ages 6-9 years old.
