WII GAME NIGHT

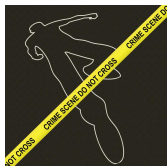

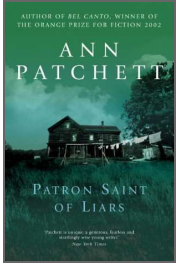


PHOTO COMPOSITION

ADULT GAME NIGHT

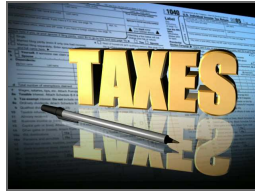
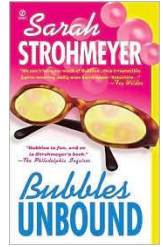

BOOK DISCUSSION GROUPS

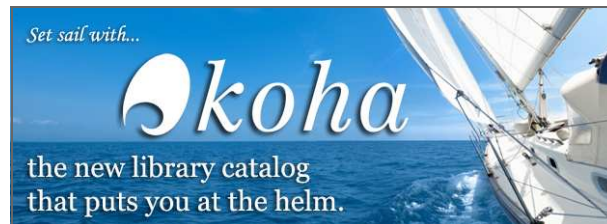

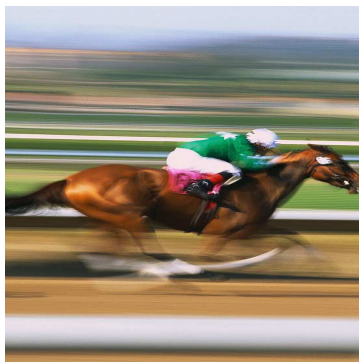
TAX PREPARATION
