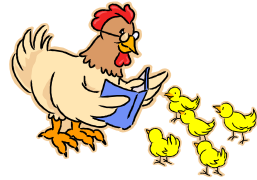

AUTHOR VISIT

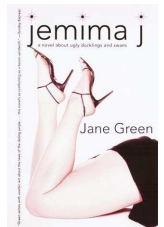

BOOK DISCUSSION GROUPS

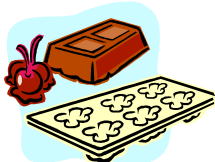
