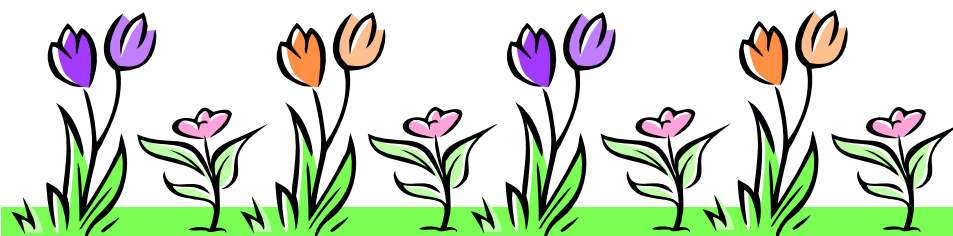

4-25 Little Bunny

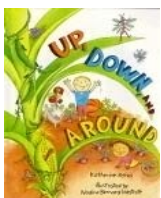
MATINEE @ THE LIBRARY
