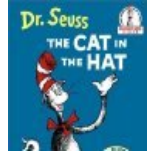

COMPUTER WORKSHOP

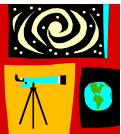

RAIN BARREL WORKSHOP



On Saturday, March 21 @ 1:00 PM will be a *Rain Barrel Workshop* led by Lee Murphy of the Northumberland County Master Gardeners Program. During this workshop we will be creating a rain barrel which will then be given away to one lucky attendee. Benefits of using a rain barrel include: watering your garden with free water, is great for plants, connect a soaker hose to your barrel and create a great way to water shallow rooted plants such as rhododendrons; rain water is usually soft and free of dissolved minerals. This untreated water is great for your plants, your lawn, or washing your car. Due to limited seating, registration is required call 538-1381.
