BOOK DISCUSSION GROUP

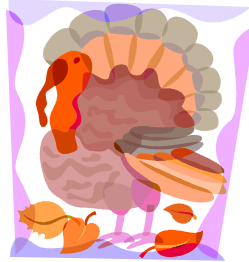
