LIBRARY TO ARCHIVE WATSONTOWN BOROUGH'S COLLECTION OF OLD WATSONTOWN NEWSPAPERS

An agreement was signed recently between the Montgomery House Warrior Run Area Public Library and the Borough of Watsontown concerning the donation, use and disposition of a collection of old Watsontown newspapers titled **The Record and Star**. Historically, **West Branch Star** was published from 1882-84 in Watsontown. Also being published was the **Watsontown Record**. **West Branch Star** bought the **Watsontown Record**, and it became **The Record and Star**.

These newspapers have been stored in the basement of the Borough office building for many years without the benefit of temperature and humidity controls.

They need to be preserved in a more environmentally controlled location with proper, supervised, access control.

The library has adequate, secure, climate controlled storage available. The borough agrees that the Library Board through their Director, will have absolute control of the access, use, long-term care and final disposition of the newspapers.

The Library agrees that access, use and final disposition of the newspapers will be within the normal standards and practices of the Library trade, considering the historical, scholastic, and personal nature of newspapers.

Thanks to Robert Franks, local historian and author, for taking the responsibility and time to transport and index these newspapers.

Mr. Franks is the author of **Warrior Run Church (1774-1964)**.
